EXHIBIT HOURS

The convention hall will <u>open</u> for setup on Friday, June 5, 2020 at 11 am and <u>close</u> at 8 pm. Saturday exhibit hours are: 9 am to 4:30 pm.

Sunday exhibit hours are: 9 am to 12 noon. We ask that you vacate your booth by 3:00 pm. Access is available one hour before opening time.

EXHIBIT SETUP

Sea-Pac will make available a group of people to assist you with your move in and move out. They will also assist you with power cords, plugs, booth carpet (if available), antenna erection (if feasible), and any other areas of need encountered.

SECURITY

Security will be provided on a 24 hour basis, night and day by an on-site professional security officer and also during the day by a team of volunteers. The volunteers will wear distinctive vests.

BOOTHS

Booth space is 8' x 10'. Each booth is draped and furnished with one (1) table 30" x 8' with covering and two chairs. No credit for tables not used. 120 volt ac power is available for an additional fee. Booth rates are shown on the contract. Payment in advance will be appreciated.
