If you would like to propose a seminar presentation, we desire the information listed below. We prefer you send an email with the info to seminars@seapac.org. Note that we usually have a fairly full program planned by mid-February, although we usually have some open time slots on Sunday morning fairly late into the planning period.

We desire to receive the following:

- Presenter name and ham call sign (if you have one). If you propose multiple presenters (such as a panel), please include names and call signs of each.
- Working title. Generally we will accept your title, but may need to negotiate due to space or other reasons.
- Brief synopsis of your topic.

After acceptance, we will request the following:

- Brief presenter bio
- Photo of you
- Whether or not you need assistants. If so, please state the specifics needed in an email.
